Welcome to EDON Place

What is the Home Security Safety Upgrades Program?

The Home Security Safety Upgrades Program aims to keep women and children safely in their homes. If you are applying for a Domestic Violence Order you may want to discuss the possibility of remaining safely in your home and applying to the courts to keep the perpetrator away from the premises and/or to have their personal belongings removed from the property.

When a current Domestic Violence Order includes the conditions of “not to enter or remain” or the condition of an “ouster” the women may be eligible for a safety upgrade assessment and plan.

The Home Security Safety Upgrades Program works with the aggrieved to assess risk and undertake an assessment of the safety and security needs identified and where appropriate the Co-ordinator will arrange for the upgrades to be implemented.

Home Security Safety Upgrade Service includes:

- Assistance with domestic & family ‘Protection Order Application’
- Assistance with an ‘Application to Vary a Domestic Violence Order’
- Comprehensive Risk Assessments
- Court Support
- Crisis Counselling
- Development of Safety Plans
- Liaison with department of housing and other local housing agents or landlords
- Provide assistance with short-term temporary accommodation for the respondents to reduce the risk of further crisis
- Provide knowledge and understanding of the relevant legislation and court process
- Referrals made to appropriate and relevant support agencies for aggrieved and respondent
- Safety audit on the women’s home and collaborate with other service providers to carry out the security upgrades
